Come to Bandwise! 2020, Music for Everyone's 21st youth Windband event. **Bandwise!** gives you the chance to play a wide variety of music for wind and percussion -- from classics to pop and jazz -- and to take part in instrumental groups and workshops, all in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

Where and when is it?

The **Bandwise!** course will be held at Bluecoat Academy, Wollaton, over the weekend of 11/12 January followed by an informal concert for parents and friends at the Albert Hall, Nottingham, on Sunday 19 January. An outline of the schedule for all groups is given overleaf.

Who will be there?

Lots of wind and percussion players from all parts of Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire, Leicestershire and Lincolnshire. All instruments are included: flutes, oboes, clarinets, bassoons, saxes, horns, trumpets, cornets, trombones, euphoniums, tubas and percussion. The age range is 8 - 21. The Artistic Director is Gill Henshaw who is an experienced wind teacher, performer and conductor. She will be assisted in conducting and leading workshops by a team of specialists. There will also be a large support group of adult organisers and helpers.



What are we playing?

A wide-ranging programme including:

- BW 1** *Wallace & Gromit Theme and Battle Pavan*
- BW 2** *Flight of the Condor and Sneak Attack*
- BW 3** *Start Up The Band and El Camino Real*

How good do I have to be?

Whether you have been playing for years or have only just reached grade 1, this is for **YOU!** Players will be divided into three groups:

Bandwise 1 (Grades 1 - 2), **Bandwise 2** (Grades 3 - 4) and **Bandwise 3** (Grade 5 and above)

N.B. Percussion players should be able to read music and play at the appropriate grade. We regret that we are unable to provide percussion instruments except timps. Kit drummers must bring their own instruments.

MfE also runs three windbands: **Nottingham Youth Band - West Bridgford** rehearses on a Tuesday from 5.30 - 7pm at the Emmanuel School, Gresham Park Road, West Bridgford NG2 7YF. **Nottingham Youth Band - Beeston** rehearses at Beeston Methodist Church on a Thursday from 5pm - 6.30pm, both are especially for players grade 2 - 5. The **East Midlands Youth Windband (EMYW)** is for more advanced players (grade 5 and above) and rehearses approx. once every three weeks on a Sunday afternoon at Nottingham Trent University, Clifton NG11 8NS. If you would like to know more then just fill in the appropriate section on the enrolment form overleaf.

How do we learn the music?

By practising the parts which will be sent to you approximately four weeks before the course, and listening to rehearsal tracks which you can choose to download or receive on a CD. These tracks take you through the music and the rehearsals at the course carry on from where they leave off. If you have 'done your homework' you'll have no problems!

How do I apply?

Just fill in the enrolment form overleaf and send it in. Numbers in each band are limited so please apply as soon as possible.
