What is the Big Youth Music Experience?

BYME brings together youth music organisations based in the East Midlands to provide exciting musical opportunities for young singers and instrumentalists aged 8 - 21. It is open to existing groups and to individuals. These workshop days are part of the **BIG YOUTH MUSIC EXPERIENCE FESTIVAL WEEKEND**, a culmination of six months of exciting music making for young singers and instrumentalists.

Who is it for?

This unique playing day for violinists, violists, cellists and bassists aged 8 to 21, grouped according to ability, offers a rich experience in technique, performance and repertoire through the expertise of professional conductors Chris George (senior group) and Rowan Cozens (junior group).

What are we playing?

SENIOR ORCHESTRA. Led by a professional string quartet the senior orchestra will study Bach's *Brandenburg Concerto No 3* and movements from Suk's *Serenade*. The workshop day will culminate in a Festival Concert at the Albert Hall, ending with a spectacular performance of 'Light of the Seven' from *Game of Thrones*. This will feature all performers plus the mighty Binns organ and Steinway grand piano!

JUNIOR ORCHESTRA. Music especially chosen for young players at the start of their string playing journey including the well known *Sailors Hornpipe* as performed at the last Night of the Proms!

Music will be sent out in advance of the playing days to allow players to become familiar with the repertoire.
