



# Youth String Workshop

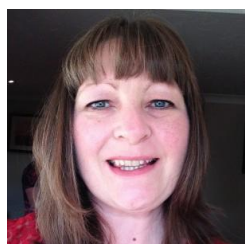
Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2021

The Senior orchestra, for players grade 5+ standard, will play **St Paul's Suite by Holst** and will be conducted by Richard Howarth, conductor of MfE's East Midlands Youth String Orchestra.
