## Birthday Celebration Concert

#### The Concert

Founded in 1985 by Angela Kay, the Nottingham Chamber Singers, part of Music for Everyone, are delighted to be celebrating forty years of music-making. The opportunity to perform great choral music season after season has been glorious and this birthday concert is a tribute to the expressive power of vocal music and the choir's love of singing. Over its four decades, the group has presented an eclectic range of repertoire, from Monteverdi's *Vespers* to McDowall's *A Fancy of Folksongs*, from Bach's *Mass in B minor* to Whitacre's *Leonardo Dreams of his Flying Machine*. The Chamber Singers have performed locally and toured to many other parts of the UK, singing in concert halls, churches and cathedrals, National Trust houses and gardens, and even in Papplewick's Pumping Station.

The programme for this their 40th birthday concert is joyous, celebratory and life affirming. It includes evocations of the healing power of music in Antony Le Fleming's *Everyone Sang*, an earlier commission by the choir, together with their latest commission, Libby Croad's *The Nightingale*. The string orchestra will perform a sumptuous arrangement of Rachmaninov's *Vocalise* and the choir will also sing the beautiful *Cantique de Jean Racine* by Fauré, Holst's richly harmonised setting of *Psalm 148* and Bliss's poetic and virtuosic choral work, *Pastoral 'Lie strewn the white flocks'*, inspired by his honeymoon on Sicily.
